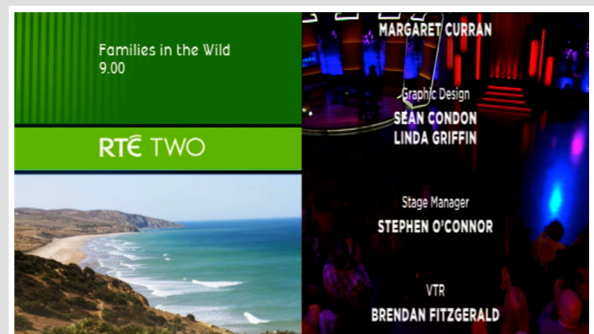
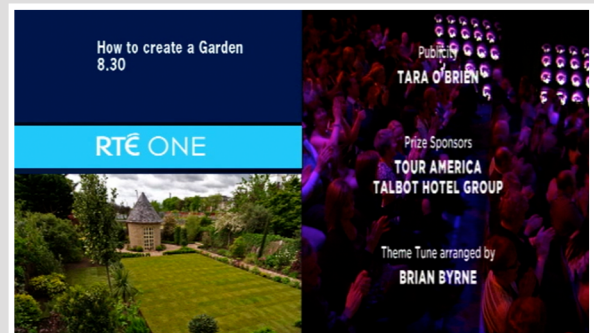




END CREDIT FORMAT GUIDELINES

All pre-recorded programmes for RTÉ ONE and RTÉ TWO for transmission after 1st November 2011 should conform to these guidelines.

- * All End Credits should be justified to the centre, on a roller and not exceeding the text safe guides. Text safe guide reference available at www.rte.ie/commissioning
- * End Credits should run over visually interesting graphics or live action but the content must not be editorially critical to the integrity of the programme. Full screen black is also acceptable.
- * Any legible font can be used. The type size should not exceed 36pt or be smaller than 28pt.
- * Credits will be squeezed to 75% of their original size. Production companies are advised to test the percentage reduction in an edit suite to ensure maximum readability.
- * All voice-overs and dialogue must be finished by the start of the credit sequence as background audio will be dipped on transmission.
- * 'Next Episode' type material previously edited into the credit sequence is no longer allowed and should wherever possible be accommodated within the programme.
- * These guidelines do not currently apply to Live Programmes or Programmes within RTEjr or TRTE.
