Setting up Google Authenticator

RTÉ have enabled 2-Step Verification, which adds an extra layer of security to your account. This means you sign in with something you know (your password) and something you have (a code sent to your phone). Each user of the system will need to download and set up the Google Authenticator App on their mobile device.

- In the Google Authenticator App select Scan a QR code (or click on the tion) and point your camera at the QR code presented in your browser. A 6 digit code will now be available for your eCommissioning account this code changes every 30 seconds.
- You will need to enter a new code each time you login to the eCommissioning system.
