2. Audience Council Presentation

The Audience Council presented to the RTÉ Board on the representation and diversity in RTÉ programming providing a cross-genre review with 5 groups focusing on selected programmes in the following areas:

- Radio & Podcasts (Morning Ireland & 2fm Breakfast)
- Cultural / Public Service Broadcasting (Saol na Feirme, Nationwide & Ear to the Ground)
- Current Affairs / News (Prime Time)
- Documentaries (The Skinny Jab Revolution & Bishop Casey's Buried Secrets)
- Drama (Fair City)

The Audience Council delivered key insights and recommendations.

In relation to Drama, the Council provided a Report from the Geena Davis Institute, a third-party company which the Council engaged to research into the representation of gender (women), race (characters of colour), age (50-plus), disability, and social class on screen, across four episodes of Fair City programmes.
